Thinking about the Easter services at BHBC, what was your standout moment?

People from the church and community stopped by to observe our Easter garden. What spoke to you from the Easter garden or what do you feel the Lord said to you while looking at it?

Read: Matthew 26:36-39

Why was it important for Jesus to take his disciples with him to the Garden of Gethsemane? When you are going through a hard time, is your normal response to reach out for support or to try to go through it alone? Why does it matter in times of crisis to be honest in prayer and open with trusted friends?

Read: Mark 14:35-36. When you are in a day of fear and pain, how do you reach out to the Lord in prayer? What example does Jesus show us and what can we learn from Him about praying during difficult times?

Read: Galatians 6:2 and Hebrews 2:18

Read: John 16:16, 20-22

When we go through a season of grief and confusion, we can be encouraged by remembering the promises of God. Because of the state of the world, many are overwhelmed with the unknown state of the future. Instead, we can hold on to what we know to be true. Which truths about God bring you comfort? Which promises in the Bible encourage you?

Read: 2 Corinthians 1:20

Read: Romans 8:11. During times of freedom and joy, we need to rely on the power of the Lord. What does it mean to you knowing that the Spirit who raised Christ from the dead lives in you as a believer?

Read: John 11:25-26; Ephesians 1:19-21; Romans 10:9.

What steps do you need to take this Easter to turn the management of your life over to Jesus completely? If you've done that already, who do you know who needs to be set free from worry and fear, and how can you encourage them to make this decision?

Read Ephesians 1:19-21 together as a prayer.
